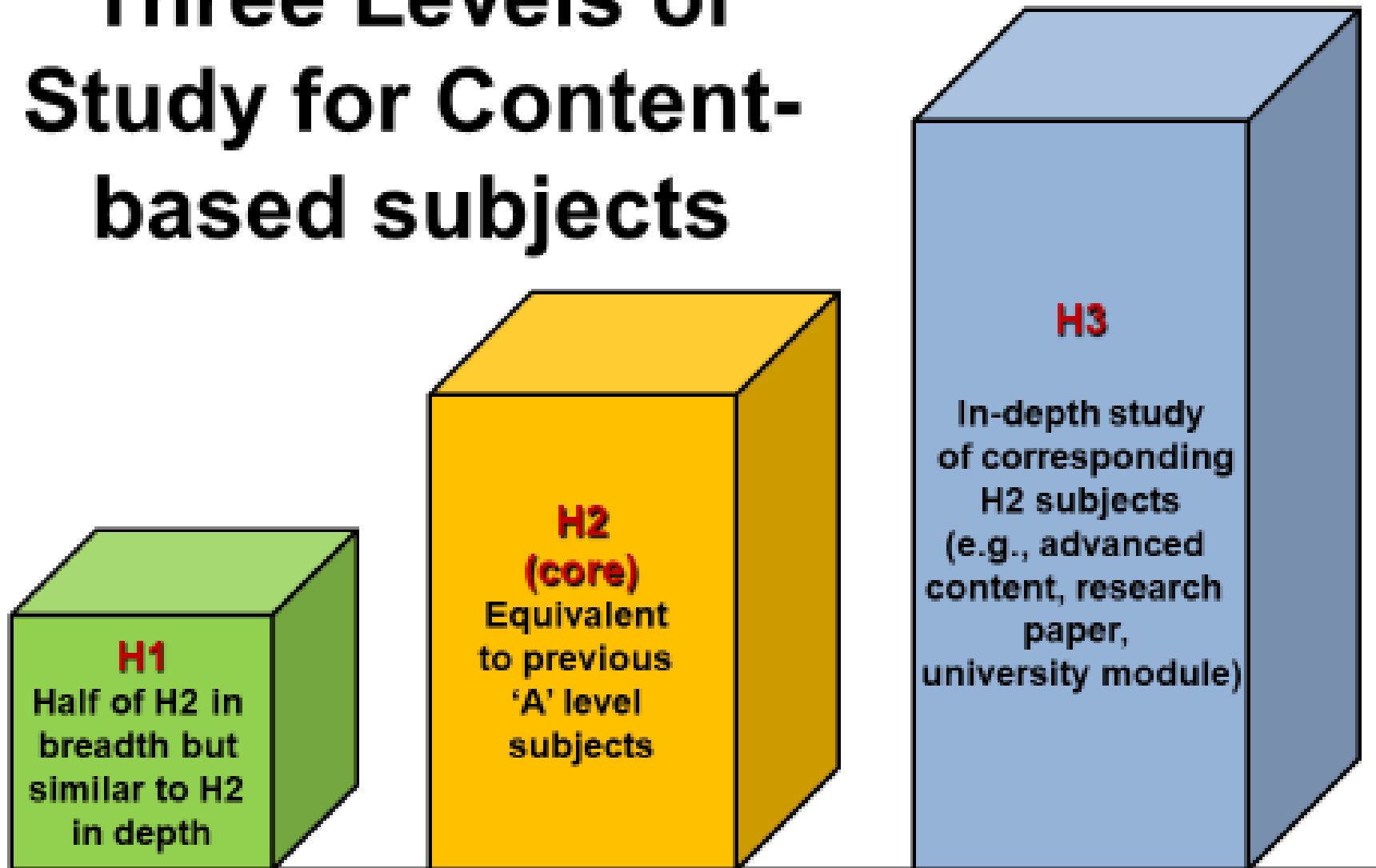

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JC1 Promotional Criteria

Passes in at least 2 H2 and 2 H1 subjects

- From an offering of 3 H2 + 2 H1 OR 4 H2 + 1 H1
- Passing Mark = 45 marks out of 100
- An “S” grade in a H2 subject = Pass in H1 subject
- These subjects exclude Project Work

Continuing with 4H2 Subjects

- In order to continue with 4 H2 subjects in JC2, a student has to pass **all** H2 subjects in the JC1 **common test and final exams**.
- The Common Test would be a platform to engage students and parents concerning this.

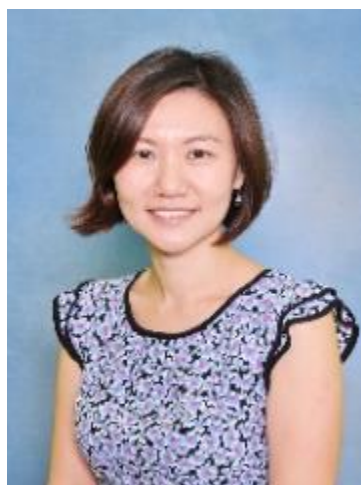

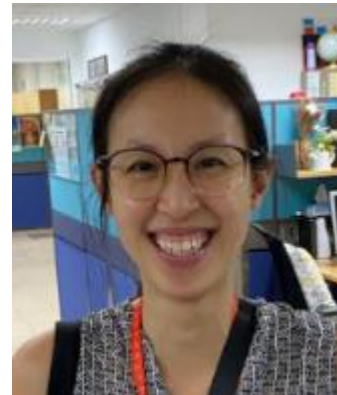
