

Dear Saints from graduating batch of 2023,

1. The release of the 2023 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 23 February 2024 (Friday) at 2.30 pm.

Collection of Examination Results

2. You may collect your result slips and certificates in the **school hall** from 2.30 pm on <u>23 February 2024</u>.

3. For the release of 2023 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB)'s Candidates Portal at <u>www.seab.gov.sg</u> from <u>3.15pm</u> on Friday, 23 February 2024 till 11.59pm on Thursday, 7 March 2024. Should you be unwell on the day of the results release, it is advisable to exercise social responsibility and not return to school to collect your results, and to collect it online instead.

4. School candidates who are eligible for SingPass¹ can use their SingPass account to access SEAB's Candidates portal. GCE A-Level candidates who are eligible for Singpass are to apply and activate their Singpass account so that they can view their results online. For students whose Singpass PIN had expired, they can reset their password instantly online or request for a new PIN mailer via Singpass website (www.singpass.gov.sg). School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from Tuesday, 20 February 2024.

5. The guide to access the SEAB's Candidates Portal can be found on the SEAB website via the link <u>CP user guide</u>.

6. School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release may authorise proxies to collect the results on their behalf. These candidates are required to complete the authorisation letter from the college website and collect the collaterals from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday.

Applications to Autonomous Universities

7. Applications for admissions and/or scholarships to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) can be done online. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online do not need to submit a copy of their A-Level certificates. More information on the AUs' admissions processes can be found on their respective websites, and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.

10. Students can also walk-in for face-to-face sessions with ECG Counsellors who will be available on the **day of GCE A-level results release, 2.00 pm to 5.30 pm at the School Library**. In addition, appointments can be made to speak with our ECG counsellor, Ms Kathena Lim any other day after results release.

1	Can I ask somebody to collect my results slip & certificate on my behalf?
	For the release of 2023 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal (<u>www.seab.gov.sg</u>) from 3.15pm. The system will be accessible from 23 February 2024 to 7 March 2024. Candidate Portal user guide for more information: <u>https://myexams.seab.gov.sg/faq/ActivateAccount.pdf</u>
2	Can I collect the hardcopy of my results slip & certificate on another day?
	School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release, may collect their results from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday or nominate a proxy to collect on behalf. The proxy should first make an appointment with the college on the time and date. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <u>https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</u>) and all required documentation on the day of collection. All results are to be collected by 01 March 2024.
3	I am currently overseas, can the college mail the hardcopy collaterals?
	No. All hardcopy collaterals will not be posted. Students can authorise a proxy via the authorisation letter and collect the collaterals from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <u>https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</u>) and all required documentation on the day of collection.
4	Can I as a proxy collect the hardcopy of my friend's results slip & certificate if I am from a different class?
	Yes. Collection can be made at the General Office from 4 pm . The proxy must submit the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <u>https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</u>) to the general office and bring all required documentation on the day of collection.
5	Can I as a proxy collect the hardcopy of my friend's results slip & certificate if I am from the same class?
	Yes. Collection can be made from your CT/CTA. The proxy must submit the authorisation letter (available from the college website: <u>https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/</u>) to your CT/CTA and bring all required documentation on the day of collection.
