

### **Assessment Plan for JC1 in 2025 (Internal examinations)**

Both weighted assessments (WA) and non-weighted assessments will be conducted to check for students' understanding on their learning. WAs may take the form of class tests, practical tests, assignments, etc. Subject teachers will inform students of the dates for WA and ensure that the number of WAs students are given is manageable.

Students must present valid reasons should they miss any WA and alternative arrangements will be made for them.

**Note that e-MC or Parent's letters are not accepted as valid reasons for absence from all assessments (include WAs and Final Examinations).**
