- Whether you're attending conferences, workshops, on school exchange program, the location provides the perfect balance of **convenience** and **accessibility** for guests.

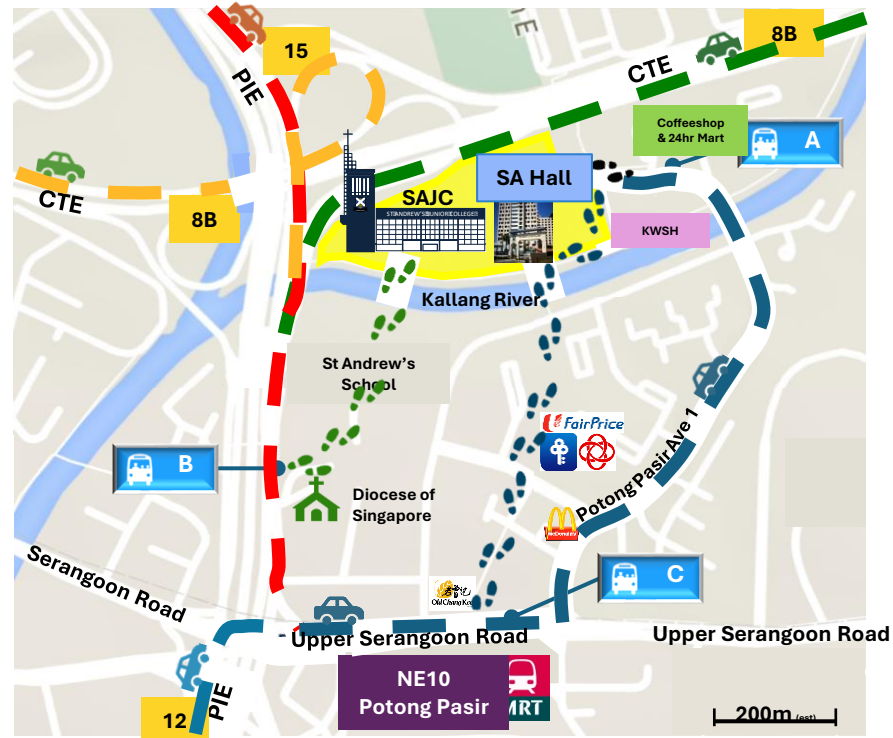


# How to get to St Andrew's Hall (SA Hall)

<b>Getting to SAH via PIE &amp; CTE</b>	
	<b>From PIE (Towards Changi)</b> Take <b>Exit 15</b> for CTE towards SLE/TPE Keep right and merge onto Jalan Toa Payoh
	<b>From PIE (Towards Jurong)</b> Take <b>Exit 12</b> for PIE
	<b>From CTE (Towards City)</b> Take <b>Exit 8B</b> for PIE Merge into Jalan Toa Payoh
	<b>From CTE (Towards Ang Mo Kio)</b> Take <b>Exit 8B</b> for PIE Merge into Jalan Toa Payoh
	<b>Make a turn into Upper Serangoon Road</b> Make a left turn into Potong Pasir Ave 1 Drive along to Potong Pasir Ave 1 to SAJC

	Direct Bus 142 from Toa Payoh Interchange Alight at Potong Pasir Ave 1, Block 120 in front of SAJC main gate
Bus Stop B (No. 60081, along PIE)	
This option is only for SAJC students.

Bus Stop C (No. 60261)	Train

Alight at Upper Serangoon Road / Potong Pasir MRT Station	Alight at Potong Pasir MRT Station (NE10) Take Exit C
	From Bus stop C, you can either take feeder bus 142 to Bus stop A or take a short 7 minutes walk through the HDB blocks to <b>SA Hall</b>
