1. The release of the 2025 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 27 February 2026 (Friday) at 2.30 pm.

Collection of Examination Results

2. You may collect your result slips and certificates in the **school hall** from 2.30 pm on 27 February 2026.

3. If you are unwell on the day of the results release, please exercise social responsibility and do not return to school to collect your results. For the release of 2025 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal (www.seab.gov.sg) from 3.15pm on Friday, 27 February 2026 till 11 pm on Friday, 13 March 2026.

4. School candidates who are eligible for SingPass¹ can use their SingPass account to access SEAB's Candidates Portal. School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from Wednesday, 25 February 2026. 5. School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release may authorise proxies to collect the results on their behalf. These candidates are required to complete the authorisation letter from the college website (<https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/>) and collect the collaterals from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday.

Applications to Autonomous Universities

6. Applications for admissions to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) and for the AU scholarships can be done online via the respective AUs' websites. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online do not need to submit a copy of their GCE A-Level certificates. More information on the AUs' admissions processes can be found on their respective websites, and applicants should approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.

Alternatively, students may also make an appointment for online or phone counselling with an ECG Counsellor from the ECG Centre at MOE (Grange Road) via the e-Appointment system at <https://go.gov.sg/moe-ecg-centre>, calling the ECG hotline at 6831 1420, or emailing MOE_ECG@moe.gov.sg. The online or phone counselling services would be available from Monday, 23 February 2026 to Thursday, 19 March 2026 from 9am to 5pm on weekdays, and 9am to 12pm on Saturdays.

Annex A - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR 2025 SINGAPORE-CAMBRIDGE GCE A-LEVEL EXAMINATION RESULTS RELEASE

1	Can I ask somebody to collect my results slip & certificate on my behalf? For the release of 2025 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal (www.seab.gov.sg). The system will be accessible from 3.15pm on Friday, 27 February 2026, till 11pm on Friday, 13 March 2026. Candidate Portal user guide for more information: https://myexams.seab.gov.sg/faq/ActivateAccount.pdf
2	Can I collect the hardcopy of my results slip & certificate on another day? School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release, may collect their results from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday or nominate a proxy to collect on behalf. The proxy should first make an appointment with the college on the time and date. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter (available from the college website: https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/) and all required documentation on the day of collection. All results are to be collected by 13 March 2026.
3	I am currently overseas, can the college mail the hardcopy collaterals? No. All hardcopy collaterals will not be posted. Students can authorise a proxy via the authorisation letter and collect the collaterals from the General Office during office hours from Monday to Friday. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter (available from the college website: https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/) and all required documentation on the day of collection.
4	Can I as a proxy collect the hardcopy of my friend's results slip & certificate if I am from a different class? Yes. Collection can be made at the General Office from 4 pm . The proxy must submit the authorisation letter (available from the college website: https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/) to the general office and bring all required documentation on the day of collection.
5	Can I as a proxy collect the hardcopy of my friend's results slip & certificate if I am from the same class? Yes. Collection can be made from your CT/CTA. The proxy must submit the authorisation letter (available from the college website: https://standrewsjc.moe.edu.sg/) to your CT/CTA and bring all required documentation on the day of collection.
