5. Character and Citizenship Education (CCE)

Servant Leadership Education And Development (SLEAD)

In line with the College's vision, Servant Leadership Education And Development (SLEAD) aims to provide a coherent focus to educating and developing every Saint to be a Servant Leader. A Servant Leader practises 3 key Habits; beginning with the heart that 'desires to serve', followed by the head that 'learns to lead', finally culminating in the hand that 'dares to act'. We believe that these Habits will help instil in our students the four Qualities of a Saint — Exemplary Character, Skilled Communicator, Holistic Thinker, and Community Builder.

Student Leadership

Student leadership development continues to be a key pillar in nurturing Saints to be Servant Leaders Who Bring Life to the Nations. SAJC aspires for each Saint to be a Servant Leader in his or her own capacity, exercising both self-leadership and influence regardless of their position or title in life.

Over the past year, Saints have stepped up to lead their peers in their CCAs and classes. The CCA Leaders and Class Leaders played a key role in looking out for the well-being of their peers and in keeping College spirit up through class and CCA-bonding activities both in person and online. In November 2020, all CCA Leaders and Class Leaders were trained in strengths-based leadership principles that equipped them to lead from their natural talents and strengths. CCA Leaders also participated in the annual CCA Leaders Webinar, where they shared their experiences and crowdsourced solutions to the challenges they faced. Similarly, the Class Leaders participated in the inaugural Class Leaders Webinar, which provided them the opportunity to learn key pastoral care and organisational skills, as well as

the platform to discuss concrete plans to build positive class culture in the year ahead.

The SAJC experience would not be complete if not for Saints who have stepped forward to lead the College. As student leaders, Student Councillors serve and lead their peers, influencing and rallying them to promote College and House spirit through various platforms. The 43rd Student Council led several College-wide initiatives during the Home-Based Learning period in 2020, working closely with the Class Leaders to organize activities for class cohesion and to raise student morale. The 43rd Student Council's mettle continued to be tested in 2021 where they redesigned signature College events like Open House and Orientation to meet Covid-19 safe management measures. They spearheaded the inaugural Saints Homecoming, a College-wide games day held in conjunction with the first ever virtual Open House. They also demonstrated spirit and determination in designing Orientation 2021, innovating to include a virtual segment for the very first time. Their efforts allowed the incoming JC1 cohort to still experience a meaningful and memorable Orientation. Such opportunities provide authentic learning experiences for Student Councillors in their development as Servant Leaders who lead and inspire the student body to love and care for the St Andrew's Family.

Service Learning

Service Learning (SL) in SAJC is an important experience that helps our Saints grow as passionate Community Builders. On SL Days, students are given time and space to learn as they serve their community.

In April 2021, even while keeping to the Safe Management Measures (SMM) restrictions due to the Covid-19 pandemic, JC2 SL Day provided our JC2 students with service learning experiences, either through face-to-face service, remote service or social advocacy. JC2 classes were all given the opportunity to initiate, plan and execute their own projects with a partner organisation of their choice. We are heartened by the students' efforts to reach out to the beneficiaries and the deep meaning and joy they have experienced in carrying out acts of service for the community. Student reflections were collated and captured on a website launched this year.

In August 2020, also in view of the restrictions on social gathering post circuit breaker period, our JC1 classes harnessed technology to bridge physical distances with senior beneficiaries, teaching them new and useful skills via the Saints' Intergenerational Learning (SAIL) with Seniors project. This was held in collaboration with our 3 major partners: Central Singapore Community Development Council (CSCDC), Fei Yue Community Services (FYCS), and Metropolitan YMCA (MYMCA). The JC1 students served as content creators for online workshops involving elderly beneficiaries from FYCS and CSCDC. The workshops covered topics relevant to the seniors. Our JC1 Saints also packed goodie bags for elderly beneficiaries from CSCDC and MYMCA.

Citizenship Education

2020 and 2021 witnessed many CE programmes adopt a more practical meaning as students and staff alike performed their duties as both citizens and residents of Singapore, to keep SAJC safe from the Covid-19 virus. Beyond the daily routines

and safe management measures, Saints had the opportunity to express words of affirmation and acts of gratitude for our healthcare workers and other frontline staff, like the cleaners and security guards in the College, showcasing the Singapore spirit of solidarity in times of crisis.

Commemorating National Day on 7 Aug 2020, our JC2 students embarked on an online social advocacy campaign, learning to utilise videos to spread awareness of social causes such as protecting the environment, caring for seniors and leading a healthy lifestyle to promote mental and physical well-being. This campaign was organised in partnership with CSCDC. Mayor Denise Phua and her team visited the College and attended this online video creation workshop. Mayor also engaged students virtually in a webinar question and answer session. This online experience gave our students the opportunity to understand what it means to be a community builder and how they can still make a positive contribution to Singapore during the Covid-19 period.

April 2021 marked the commemoration of International Friendship Day and part of our activities involved a competition for the JC2 students to explore the international communities residing in Singapore and their significance to society. They explored 'The World in Singapore' through the research of different expatriate communities residing in Singapore like the Japanese, Koreans and the Filipinos. Their challenge was to better understand and appreciate the culture and practices of these international communities. JC1 students were treated to an SG Perspectives dialogue session with Ambassador Wong Kwok Pun. Conducted in a blended format, the live session with students from the 44th Student Council engaging the ambassador with questions in Lecture Theatre 1 was simultaneously streamed to the rest of the cohort in the classrooms to glean insights into Singapore's Foreign Policy. The theme of International Friendship carried on into the month of May with the online hosting of the EU@your school Programme, during which Portuguese Ambassador Mário Duarte engaged our students in a virtual dialogue on the future of EU-Singapore relations. Ultimately, Saints learnt through these series of events that despite global disruptions, good international relationships remain a crucial factor for the success of Singapore.
