Dear Saints from graduating batch of 2021,

1. The release of the 2021 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 22 February 2022 (Tuesday) at 2 pm. In view of the Covid-19 situation, the Ministry of Education and Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB) have made special arrangements for school candidates to receive their results from the respective schools.

Collection of Examination Results

- 2. If you are well, you may collect your result slips and certificates in the school from 2 pm on 22 February 2022. All returning students are expected to observe the Safe Management Measures in place. You will be collecting your results in a classroom. (Annex A: Venue of results distribution).
- 3. Please note that candidates collecting their results will only be allowed entry to the school premises from 1 pm. Other accompanying family members will not be allowed into the school premises in view of the current COVID-19 situation. Correspondingly, car parking will not be extended to any candidates or their family members. Instead, you may park at the HDB car parks near the school premises.
- 4. If you have been issued with the Ministry of Health's Health Risk Warning, you will only be allowed to collect your results in person if you test negative using the Antigen Rapid Test (ART) on the day of the results release before going to school.
- 5. If you are unwell on the day of the results release or are required to self-isolate due to a positive COVID-19 test result, please do not return to school to collect your results. For the release of 2021 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal (www.seab.gov.sg) from 2.45pm.
- 6. School candidates who are eligible for SingPass¹ can use their SingPass account to access SEAB's Candidates portal. School candidates who are International Students will receive their system-generated username via email from 17 February 2022. The system will be accessible from 22 February 2022 to 8 March 2022. - 7. School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release may authorise proxies to collect the results on their behalf. These candidates are required to complete the authorisation letter from the college website and contact the school at 62857008 at <u>least one day in advance</u>. The college will then advise them on suitable arrangement to collect their results. Proxies are required to collect the results by 25 February 2022.

Applications to Autonomous Universities

8. Applications for admissions and/or scholarships to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) can be done online. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online do not need to submit a copy of their A-Level certificates. More information on the AUs' admissions processes can be found on their respective websites, and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.

Education and Career Guidance (ECG)

- 9. Students who need further advice on career guidance, university courses or scholarship application matters, can make an appointment for online or phone counselling with an ECG Counsellor from the ECG Centre at MOE (Grange Road) via the e-Appointment system at https://go.gov.sg/moe-ecg-centre, calling the ECG hotline at 6831 1420, or emailing MOE ECG@moe.gov.sg. The MOE ECG Centre will offer online or phone counselling from 14 February to 19 March 2022, 9.00am to 5.00pm (Saturdays: 9.00am to 12.30pm).
- 10. Students can also walk-in for face-to-face sessions with ECG Counsellors who will be available on the **day of GCE A-level results release**, **2.00 pm to 5.30 pm at the School Library**. In addition, appointments can be made to speak with our ECG counsellor, Ms Kathena Lim any other day after results release.

1 How can I help the school if I am collecting results slip & certificate in school?

All returning students who are well are to use their TraceTogetherApp to check into SAJC via SafeEntry. Please enter the college via the **main gate** from 1 pm.

2 Can I ask somebody to collect my results slip & certificate on my behalf?

For the release of 2021 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's Candidates Portal (www.seab.gov.sg) from 2.45pm. The system will be accessible from 22 February 2022 to 8 March 2022.

3 Can I collect the hardcopy of my results slip & certificate on another day?

For school candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release, they can print the authorization letter from the college website and contact the school at least one day in advance **(62857008)** who will then advise them on suitable arrangement to collect their results. Proxies are required to collect the results by 25 February 2022.

4 | I am currently overseas, can the college mail the hardcopy collaterals?

No. All hardcopy collaterals will not be posted. Students can authorise a proxy via the authorisation letter. The proxy should first make an appointment with the college on the time and date. The proxy must bring the authorisation letter and all required documentation on the day of collection.
