

Dear Saints from graduating batch of 2020,

1. The release of the 2020 GCE A-Level examination results will take place on 19 February 2021 (Friday) at 2.30pm. In view of the Covid-19 situation, the Ministry of Education and Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB) have made special arrangements for school candidates to receive their results from the respective schools.

### Collection of Examination Results

2. If you are well, you may collect your result slips and certificates in the school from 2.30pm on 19 February 2021. All returning students are to check into SAJC via SafeEntry and also have your temperature taken. You will be collecting your results in a classroom instead of the school hall (**Annex A: Venue of results distribution**).

3. **Please note that candidates collecting their results will only be allowed entry to the school premises from 1.30pm. Other accompanying family members will not be allowed into the school premises in view of the current COVID-19 situation.** Correspondingly, car parking will not be extended to any candidates or their family members. Instead, you may park at the HDB car parks near the school premises.

4. If you are unwell, on Leave of Absence (LOA) or Quarantine Order (QO) on the day of the results release, please do not return to school to collect your results. For the release of 2020 A-Level Examination Results, all candidates regardless of whether they are in Singapore or overseas, will be able to access their results online via SEAB's result release system ([www.seab.gov.sg](http://www.seab.gov.sg)) from 3.15pm.

5. School candidates who are eligible for SingPass<sup>1</sup> can use their SingPass account to access SEAB's online results release system. School candidates who are International Students can access the results release system using the SEAB-issued PIN sent to their email addresses. The system will be accessible from 19 February 2021 to 5 March 2021. You may refer to the following **Results release user guide** for more information: <https://tinyurl.com/Resultsreleaseuserguide>

6. School candidates who wish to receive their hardcopy results but are unable to do so on the day of the A-Level results release may authorise proxies to collect the results on their behalf. These candidates are required to complete the authorisation letter from the college website and contact the school at 62857008 at **least one day in advance**. The college will then advise them on suitable arrangement to collect their results. Proxies are required to collect the results by 23 February 2021.

### Applications to Autonomous Universities

7. Applications for admissions and/or scholarships to the local Autonomous Universities (AUs) can be done online. All school candidates who apply to the local AUs online do not need to submit a copy of their A-Level certificates. More information on the AUs' admissions processes can be found on their respective websites, and applicants can approach the AUs directly for further clarifications.
