**(6) A level Certificate / SGC Amendment Request**

**A level certificate:**

- (a) Students may request for a re-print of their certificate only if their name has been printed wrongly due to misspelling. There will be an amendment fee of **\$50 for each A-level Certificate** that requires a re-print.
- (b) Closing date for the request is **29 May 2020, 12 p.m.** All errors must be submitted through the school (at the General Office) during office hours.

**SGC Amendment Request:**

- (a) Errors for SGC (e.g. name) are to be reported as soon as possible at the general office and a photocopy of the error must be clearly shown.
- (b) MOE will take about 2 – 4 weeks to print the corrected SGC & Testimonial.

Do note that Students will exchange the inaccurate documents with the corrected documents at the GO.

### **(7) Individual Appeal for Review of Results**

- (a) The appeal for review of results is to verify if your GCE results are correct. The review of results covers only the review of the marking and a full clerical re-check. No report on the candidate's performance will be provided.

The fees (inclusive of 7% GST) are for individual appeals are as follows:

S\$112.35 per H1-level subject

S\$181.90 per H2-level subject

S\$181.90 per H3-level subject

- (b) Closing date for the application for appeal of results and the payment of appeal fees:  
**28 February 2020, 12 p.m.**

Appeal applications and payment made after the closing date will not be considered.

- (c) All appeals must be submitted through the school (at the General Office) during office hours.  
**Appeal forms are available at the General Office.**

### **(8) Repeating JC2**

#### **Criteria:**

JC2 students are allowed to repeat JC2 and their A-Level if they satisfy **all** the criteria below:

- (a) Failed General Paper **or** did not obtain a minimum of 3 passes in their H2 content-based subjects.

- (b) (i) Will not be more than 4 years overage for Singapore Citizens / Permanent Resident (born on or **after** 2 Jan 1998).

- (ii) Will not be more than 2 years overage for International Students (born on or after 2 Jan 2000).

- (c) Attempted the GCE 'A' Level Examination for the first time in 2019.

**Note:** The applicant's Conduct Grade and Comments from Subject Tutors and Civics Tutors are also taken into consideration. 4H2 students are only allowed to repeat with a 3H2 subject combination.

#### **Application Process:**

- Students who are eligible and wish to repeat JC2 should complete an application form (available at the general office) & submit it to the General Office by **26 February 2020, 12 p.m.**
- Repeat students are also to complete the "Extension of Concessionary Travel of School Smart Card for A-Level Repeat Students" form available at the General Office.
- **Male students** who have been enlisted for NS in Dec 2019 or earmarked for enlistment for NS in Mar 2020 or later must apply for disruption/deferment. Letter of Support for NS disruption/deferment, are available at the General Office.

### **(9) Repeating A levels as a Private Candidate**

Note that in the computation of UAS (University Admission Points or Rank Points), the results from H1 GP and 3 H2 Content Subjects must be taken in one sitting. Hence, students who did not score an A in the H1 Content Subject may re-sit for it as a private candidate and improve on the UAS if the new result is better. However, should the result in the re-sit be inferior, the new grade will be discounted and the UAS will be unchanged.
