#### D. Terms

1. Student's application must reach St Andrew's Hall General Office (GO) at least 1 month before the start of the new school term.
2. Student is required to pass the admissions interview conducted by the Selection Committee before he/she is offered a place in the Hall.
3. Upon granting lodging at St Andrew's Hall, all boarders (sent by MOE or otherwise) MUST abide by the rules and regulations of the Hall.
4. Boarders are to participate in all planned activities/programs in the Hall.
5. Early withdrawal :  
The minimum stay is six (6) months. Should there be a need for early withdrawal, GO must be notified at least one month ahead to allow for administrative follow up. Notification is made through completing the "Application to Withdraw from SA Hall". In addition, documentary proof is required. For Self-paying Boarder, Parent's letter is to be attached.  
  
Deposit may be forfeited if
  - it is deemed that there are no valid reasons for early withdrawal or
  - stay is less than 6 months or
  - one month notice is not given as required
6. Fees matters:  
First payment of Hall fees must be paid at least a week before the commencement date of stay. Fees are based on the rate at the point of application. Subsequently, fees (based on the rate quoted for the period of stay) are collected once a quarter in January, April, July and October. Payment must be made at GO or via bank transfer and at least 2 working days before the start of the new quarter.
  - For Scholar, all fees borne by MOE except for miscellaneous costs like bus fares, replacement of lost Hall's assets, Hall T-shirts etc which are borne by the Scholar
  - For Self-paying Boarder, all fees and miscellaneous Hall expenses are borne by the Boarder
7. For self-paying boarder, you are strongly encouraged to buy a medical insurance during your stay at SA Hall.
8. The Hall reserves the right to rescind the offer to stay if the Boarder is found to have infringed rules or misbehaved. All deposits and fees may be forfeited.
9. Boarders, who withdraw from St Andrew's Hall (SAH), are not allowed to re-apply within twelve (12) months from their withdrawal date from SAH. In addition, boarders, who are dismissed or expelled by SAH due to mis-conduct, are permanently not allowed to apply again.
